- **Served as a “lay” magistrate (judge) at Stratford Court, one of the largest benches in Great Britain**
- She worked as a social welfare officer for 35 years
- President of her local Conservative Party
- Provided musical entertainment for WWII soldiers
- Campaigned for increased maritime safety
- Started a local branch of the Women’s Junior Air Corps during WWII

### **PLUS:**

- Eva was appointed *Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire (MBE)* by the Queen of England at Buckingham Palace
- Eva’s mother planned to have her sing in a shipboard concert during the crossing
- On board, Eva’s mother slept during the day so that she would be wide awake at night, due to a premonition of disaster
- “Stay with mummy and hold her hand tightly like a good girl,” were her father’s last words
- Born 1905, London, England - Died 1996, London, England
