*What is *steampunk* and what has it to do with *Titanic*? The term *steampunk* was coined by author K.W. Jeter in 1987 to describe an inventive mash-up of Victorian/ Edwardian history and science fiction - a time when *steam*, not *electricity*, drove technological advancements. *Titanic* was the ultimate steam machine in 1912, the queen of propulsion and steam pump power. Today she is hailed as an icon of *steampunk* culture.
